### Coats for Kids

Council #12423 and St. Stan's Parishioners teamed up in October to raise funds to purchase winter items for distribution to needy families. Thanks to your generosity, over \$700 was raised, allowing more than 45 area children — including some of your fellow parishioners — to have coats and boots to see them through. Thank you! Thanks also to Meijer on Pine St. in Essexville for their donation toward this effort!

### Food Drive

In November, St. Stan's parishioners turned out in droves to support the Council #12423 *Neighbors Helping Neighbors* food drive, to benefit the St. Stanislaus Food Pantry. Embracing a new approach, parishioners took home a "Menu Bag" and filled it with the suggested items in one of four need areas: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, and Personal Care Items.

Amazingly, more than 500 bags of food were donated through this program, representing well over 5,000lbs of food for the pantry. The collection was so large, it took over the Council #12423 meeting room (*see picture at right*). In addition, cash donations purchased holiday hams for families in need. Thank you for the tremendous support! Thanks also to Meijer on Wilder for donating the bags for this year's drive.

### Diaper Drive for AAI

November was Respect Life month, and St. Stan's parishioners showed their true colors. Through their participation in our Diaper Drive, 1,681 diapers, over 1,000 baby wipes, and a variety of other baby supplies were donated to Abortion Alternatives Inc. in Saginaw, for distribution to mothers who chose LIFE.
